BART operates train service from SFO to northern San Mateo County, San Francisco, and the East Bay. The SFO BART Station is located in the International Terminal on the Departures/Ticketing Level, "G" side. From other terminals, ride the AirTrain to Garage G/BART station. BART fares are distance-based and vary by trip destination. Fare to Downtown San Francisco is \$9.65. For detailed fare information or to purchase tickets, inquire at the SFO BART Station or at staffed Airport Information Booths on the Arrivals/Baggage Claim level of each terminal.
